- -A THREE-COUNTY HEALTH PRIORITIZATION ADVISORY TEAM MET TO DETERMINE
- HEALTH PRIORITIES FOR EACH COUNTY ON DECEMBER 1, 2015.
- -A COMMUNITY FORUM WAS HELD ON JANUARY 27, 2016 WITH 39 COMMUNITY
- STAKEHOLDERS. THE AUDIENCE CONSISTED OF HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS, THE HEALTH
- DEPARTMENT, BUSINESS LEADERS, SCHOOL SYSTEMS, GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES,


