With more than 410,000 cancer survivors living in Georgia, Georgia CORE is focused on improving the quality of life for survivors. An advisory board of cancer survivors guides the development of programs including comprehensive online cancer information centers (www.GeorgiaCancerInfo.org and www.GeorgiaCancerInfo.org/survivorship) to connect patients and survivors to needed resources. In 2014, a statewide needs assessment was conducted to determine the unmet needs of Georgia's cancer survivors. Dissemination of the survey results is currently underway. A statewide network of patient navigators receives training, tools, and support to assist patients and survivors in cancer centers across the state.
