

THE COMPARISONS ARE BASED UPON TOTAL STATE ASSOCIATION REVENUES, CONSIDERING THE AGGREGATE ASSOCIATION REVENUES, AS WELL AS THEIR SUBSIDIARY CORPORATION REVENUES. THE RESULTS OF THIS REVIEW ARE SENT TO THE THA CHAIRMAN. THE COMPENSATION COMMITTEE CONSISTING OF THE CHAIRMAN, THE CHAIR-ELECT, AND THE IMMEDIATE PAST CHAIR THEN MEET TO DISCUSS THE RESULTS AND APPROVE THE CEO'S

COMPENSATION. MINUTES FOR THESE MEETINGS ARE PREPARED BY THE CEO AND MAINTAINED BY HIS EXECUTIVE SECRETARY.
