During the first eight months of 2017, HASER conducted a handful of educational activities with community groups from the Municipality of Carolina that include art installations with local youth and international participants, educational workshops about social justice and supported the travel of community members to present their work and what we are doing in Puerto Rico. In September 20, 2017 Hurricane Maria hit. Everything changed for HASER because we focused our efforts on hurricane relief support to many communities around Puerto Rico. We received donations for the acquisitions and disbursement of essential necessities for families and communities that had lost their livelihood during the hurricane. This included water filters, solar systems to run medical machines, communication technology and perishable food. We also invested donations we received in equipment and materials to clear up roads, by ways and entrances to homes. We were able to purchase materials for rebuilding some roofs of low-income families that had lost their entire roof or had so much water filtration that their belongings were destroyed. During this time, we were able to hire a part time consultant to help with the hurricane relief work.

PART VI SECTION A 8b- All board meetings are documented on our official book. The board of directors has not given authority to any committee to act on behalf of the board of directors. During the extreme times of post hurricane Maria, the Board President work on the day to day actions of the hurricane relief work with support from the consultant.
