Line of Credit-This a revolving loan available through Nebraska Enterprise Fund. Funds are available to small business to cover cash flow. BMU generally pays it off within the first year of borrowing from the fund. Training-Classes are provided through introduction to the Trades. Funds are used to pay vendors that conduct the training. Travel-BMU rents a vehicle from time to time to transport students to various sites.
