records of Stillwater County, Montana. This easement protects 1,039 acres in the West Rosebud Valley and is adjacent to and in the vicinity
of numerous other properties that are under perpetual conservation easements. The easement was corrected by that certain Correction of
Deed of Conservation Easement (Legal Description) recorded December 21, 2017, as Document #371041 Easements, public records of
Stillwater County, MT. The correction was necessary to correct an error in the original legal description that was found when a conservation
easement was granted by an adjacent neighbor.
2) Jack Creek Preserve Foundation This Second Restatement of Deed of Conservation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation
Easement on Additional Lands, was originally recorded in the public records of Madison County, Montana, on November 12, 2015, as
Document #164191 Records. The Second Restatement was corrected by that certain Correction to Second Restatement of Deed of Conser-
vation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands recorded on June 9, 2017, as Document #172885 Records,
in the public records of Madison County, Montana. The correction was necessary to acknowledge and correct an inadvertent drafting error
referencing two existing primitive cabins, when in fact there are three primitive cabins, and to correct an error regarding the development
area, which was mistakenly located in an area of the property that contained significant wetlands such that a 5-acre building envelope
could not be located which was compatible with the conservation values. The Jack Creek Preserve consists of 4,343 acres in the Madison
Valley, where there are over 113,750 acres under protection by perpetual conservation easements held by MLR.
3) Muddy Creek Ranch, LLC This property consists of approximately 815 acres and is located within the Shields Valley, an area of Montana
under ever increasing development pressure. The original Deed of Conservation Easement was recorded on December 22, 2000, as
Document #287276, in Roll 153, pages 1201-1223, as corrected by that certain Correction to Deed of Conservation Easement recorded
on February 18, 2003, as Document #304943, in Roll 184, pages 176-178, in the public records of Park County, Montana. Development
and subdivision on the property was further restated, consolidated, and clustered via a Restatement and Amendment of Deed of
Conservation Easement that was recorded on March 7, 2017, as Document #396587, in the public records of Park County, Montana.
