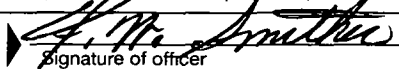

1. Pastors Philip and Alberta Derber ministered in Puerto Rico 1/23 through 2/4/2017 in three church locations, CCRVA, Juncos, and Moca, approximately 165-175 people each night for 5 meetings. They also counseled with the pastors. Many testimonies of healings and financial prosperity came forth. Cost of this trip: \$4068.00
2. Pastors Philip and Alberta Derber ministered in St. Petersburg, FL at Exceeding Grace Ministries, from February 13th to the 20th. There were 4 services of preaching, healing, and deliverance. They also counseled with the pastors. An average of 150 people attended the meetings. The cost of this trip: \$622.00
3. The RVN Band (TRM) held a concert and ministered in Gun Barrel TX, March 23rd through 27th. Three services with approximately 50 people attending each service. Dr. Derber also counseled with the pastors. The cost of this trip: \$3,481.00

6. Pastors Philip and Alberta Derber ministered in St. Petersburg, FL at Exceeding Grace Ministries, from May 3rd through May 8th. There were 4 services of preaching, healing, and deliverance. They also counseled with the pastors. An average of 150 people attended the each meeting. The cost of this trip: \$1,573
7. The RVN Band (TRM) held a concert and ministered in Buffalo, NY, at Evangel Assembly of God, June 1st through June 5th. They ministered in a total of three meetings with 100-120 people in each meeting. Dr. Derber ministered in three miracle healing services along with the the Band in concert. The cost of the trip: \$2,560.00
8. The RVN Band (TRM) ministered in concert and Dr. Derber preached in the Nepalese Church in Lexington, KY June 17th for one service. The attendance was 115 people. The cost of the trip: \$40.00
9. The RVN Band (TRM) ministered in concert and Dr. Derber preached in Fort Payne, Alabama at Fort Payne Christian Center in the Pavilion Tent Crusade. They ministered for two meetings, for approximately 150 people in each meeting. Dr. Derber ministered prophetically into people's lives and miracle healings. The cost of the trip: \$1,915.00
