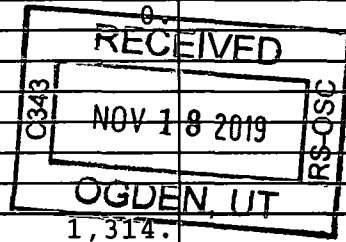

Summary of Direct Charitable Activities

The AB InBev Foundation (the "Foundation") works with program partners and a Technical Advisory Group at the global and community level to help reduce harmful drinking and effect positive change.

The Foundation's direct program activity focuses on four core areas:

1) Supporting transparent and verifiable monitoring and evaluation of AB InBev's Global Smart Drinking Goals through the Foundation's engagement of program partner HBSA, which has been measuring and evaluating the overall impact of the City Pilot initiatives on the harmful use of alcohol.

2) Guiding City Pilot initiatives in Leuven, Belgium, Brasilia, Brazil, Jiangshan, China, Zacatecas, Mexico and Columbus, Ohio (with a sixth in Johannesburg, South Africa launched in 2018), (a) with science-based interventions through the Foundation's engagement of program partner The Ohio State University, which has been working in collaboration with technical experts at other universities to develop an evidence-based alcohol harm prevention toolkit to help the communities participating in the City Pilot initiative to reach each community's goal of reducing harmful alcohol use by 10%, and (b) with technical advice through the Foundation's engagement of a Technical Advisory Group, which is a group of well-known experts in alcohol science, health communications, measurement and evaluation and other related areas who offer the Foundation advice and guidance on the overall direction and architecture for achieving the public health objectives of the Global Smart Drinking Goals.

3) Supporting the training of health care providers through the Foundation's engagement of program partner ANDHealth, which has been assisting in the implementation of primary health-care based screening and brief intervention (SBI) programs to reduce the harmful use of alcohol use in three programs of the City Pilot initiative (Leuven, Belgium, Brasilia, Brazil and Jiangshan, China).

4) Advancing alcohol health literacy – that is, knowledge of strategies to avoid harmful drinking - as an approach to reduce harmful drinking, through the Foundation's engagement of program partner Tufts University, which has been developing a consumer guidance labeling strategy for beer that will promote alcohol health literacy and reflect the current evidence base for consumer labeling.
