The primary exempt purpose of the Organization is to promote the common good and general welfare of the people of Ohio, by helping the
public learn about issues and elections that impact Ohio's business climate and economic competitiveness, providing educational services,
and encouraging the adoption of public policies that foster greater job creation, economic growth, and free enterprise.
Part IV - Compensation
No reportable conpensation is paid to Keith Lake and Jennifer Osburn through Ohioans for a Healthy Economy, Inc. In-Kind compensation
is incurred by a related organization, the Ohio Chamber of Commerce, totaling \$4,086 for Keith Lake and \$1,504 for Jennifer Osburn.
These amounts are reported as compensation on the Ohio Chamber of Commerce's Form 990 for 2017 as they are not included in any
W-2 reporting or Form 941 filings for Ohioans for a Healthy Economy, Inc.
Additional in-kind amounts from the Ohio Chamber of Commerce to Ohioans for a Healthy Economy, Inc. include \$636 of payroll related
costs, \$300 of allocated professional service costs, and \$2,500 of allocated occupancy costs.
