

Projects brought together funders, non-profits, and outside experts; funded field-wide research; increased the resilience of the field; facilitated alliances; and enabled collaborations.

Convenings and connecting the field with new allies, each other, and philanthropy

Twenty-one convenings were held, including roundtables, small group meetings, seminars, and retreats such as:

- Roundtables on funding for English as an Additional Language (EAL) and attainment of refugee children in schools
- Workshop on arts, migration and activism
- Convening of over 100 nonprofits and funders
- Migration funders' convening

Education

Several projects expanded the field and philanthropy's understanding of English as an Additional Language (EAL) and refugee children in the education system. This included research on proposed funding stream changes for EAL in schools and for research into the numbers of refugee children in English schools, and their educational attainment. Convenings of funders, school leaders, and academics to discuss the findings and the research took place.

Work on introducing migration to the GCSE History curriculum (several new modules are now part of the new curriculum) was also undertaken by 2 organizations (including events and convenings) to reinforce and expand the educational focus.

Pop culture

A small team of consultants led background research and scoping of whether and how popular culture could be a catalyst for communicating narratives to mass audiences. This work has led to a much deeper understanding of the current funding landscape for popular culture and social change work in the UK. It has also established a group of funders, NGOs, and celebrities that are interested in the development and expansion of this idea.

Research and communications

A number of projects focused on responding to the post-Brexit environment. This included convening with youth and European immigrants, and supporting work by a US-based strategic communications expert. The work has also assisted in establishing what the immigration field is doing in relation to Brexit and the extent of the gaps and opportunities that are most prevalent post-Brexit.

Civic Muslim voices

Key Muslim leaders were provided consultancy to engage in building capacity to respond publicly to salient issues with an anti-Isis campaign, training and education, media and social media outreach, developing Muslim volunteering networks, and deepening relationships with Jewish community groups. Their leadership continued to attract widespread coverage in the media.

Improving field resilience

Consultants were engaged to increase the resilience of the field, by providing to over 5 organizations advice such as on: fundraising, including on major donor and individual giving; organizational and governance; and program strategy.

2. United States Program Support for research, convenings and connecting grantees - \$288,261

Activities included:

Culture Change Strategy Project

- Held a narrative change working session in early spring 2017 with a dozen leaders in the immigrant rights field, with the intention of uncovering new opportunities for the immigrant rights movement to become more powerful and effective. This session introduced attendees to new methods and thinking about narrative and engagement.
- Co-commissioned a national market research study of over 2,500 people in late spring 2017, which helped to further disaggregate characteristics of certain segments/audiences that hold ambivalent attitudes towards immigrants and refugees. Key highlights included:
 - A close partnership with various independent data scientists, researchers, and experts during the design phase of the questionnaire. The survey included questions about respondents' immigration beliefs, economic situation and concerns, political views, media consumption and social media engagement, influencers, demographic characteristics, and psychological attributes.
 - A small group briefing in late summer 2017 for funder partners, researchers, and grantees, with the goal of sharing initial findings about the segmentation study, along with preliminary thoughts on specific subgroups that could merit further exploration and investigation. Participants discussed how to dig deeper into certain segments/audiences and begin to think about transformative ways to shift the narrative on immigration in the United States.

Family Immigration and Diversity Visas Research and Education Project

- Launched a project to conduct strategic research and educate funders on the urgency of developing funding strategies to highlight the social and economic benefits of family immigration.
- Presented findings to national foundations to build public support for family

immigration.

Uncovering New Approaches to Anti-Hate Work Project

- Launched a project to conduct strategic research and educate funders as well as advocates on the importance of shifting our understanding of effective approaches to (a) engaging in anti-hate work and/or (b) alliance building with disaffected communities that feel threatened by immigration.

Convening and Connecting Our Grantee Partners

- **National Korean American Service & Education Consortium (NAKASEC)** youth organizers and leaders attended a Youth Organizing Summit.
- **National Day Laborer Organizing Network (NDLON)** and Central American Refugee Center (CARECEN-LA), in conjunction with the National Temporary Protected Status (TPS) Alliance, hosted a National Strategy Meeting in Washington, DC in late fall 2017. The gathering convened over 300 TPS recipients from around the country to receive advocacy and media training, and conduct visits to educate federal policymakers about TPS.

3. Migration Learning Exchange Program - \$175,000

Activities included:

- A learning exchange in New York City from March 8 to 10, hosted by Purpose, a digital campaigns organization. The theme of the exchange was digital organizing for movement building in the migration field. NGO representatives from Austria, Poland, France, Germany, the UK, Ireland, and Poland gathered to share learning and hear from policy and communications experts.
- A learning exchange in Washington DC from May 15 to 19, hosted by America's Voice Educational Fund, a communications nonprofit. The theme of the exchange was strategic communications and framing migration. The exchange included hearing from people affected by existing policies and sharing the concerns of advocates who are engaging with decision-makers. There were 11 participants from nonprofits and groups in the UK and Europe (British Future, Just for Kids Law, IMiX, HOPE not hate, Women for Refugee Women, JCWI, Dutch Council for Refugees, Immigrant Council for Ireland, Law Centre Northern Ireland, North West Migrants Forum, and Human Rights Watch).
- A learning exchange in London from June 11 to 13, hosted by the Greater London Authority, London's City Hall. The theme of the exchange was municipal good practice. Mayors from leading global cities (London, New York, Los Angeles, Denver, and Paris) networked and exchanged understanding of successes and challenges incurred by cities in developing and delivering practical programs (including those with a migrant focus) which can be applied within wider urban social integration strategies.

- A learning exchange in London from July 9 to 13, hosted by HOPE not hate Charitable Trust, a community organizing nonprofit. The exchange focused on how community organizers can engage with marginalized communities such as alienated White working-class communities. 12 participants from US nonprofits Church World Service, People's Action, Make the Road New York, Michigan United, Unite Oregon, LA Voice, AFL-CIO, PANA, OCCORD, Tennessee Immigrant & Refugee Rights Coalition, and Nebraska Appleseed. The agenda included political context updates for the UK, Europe and the US; storytelling by the anchor organization; workshops; site visits in Wales; and reflections.

4. Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning - \$45,070

Consultants were engaged to collect data on field-level developments through desk research and through interviews with grantees. They examined significant events and trends in the landscape, progress achieved in the field, and challenges that individual grantees and the field as a whole are facing as well as strategies planned or under consideration for overcoming challenges. During the interview conversations, grantees were able to calibrate their experiences with others to gain insight into which directions appear to be commonly considered. The data are being shared with funders and the field.
