3) The application must be submitted to Columbus Electric Cooperative, Inc., 900 N. Gold Ave./P.O. Box 631, Deming, New Mexico 88031, by March 1.

4) The grant shall be in the amount of \$500 per year (\$250.00 per student per semester). The number of grants issued each year will be determined by the Trustees.

5) Academic accomplishments, character and need will be the determining factors in selecting the persons to receive these education grants.

6) Should the student be selected for the grant, the grant will be made available upon proof of registration for the first semester. Upon completion of the first semester, a statement will be required from the institution certifying the applicant is considered by the Registrar to be a regular full-time student in good standing with a grade point level of at least 2.5, using a 4.0 grading system. Upon receipt of this statement and proof of enrollment for the second semester, the grant will be issued to the student.
