The Foundation is governed by a 37 member Board of Directors. Members are nominated by the PHF Board Governance Committee and reflect a cross-section of community leaders. All nominations are approved by the PHF and PHS Board, the Chair of the Foundation Board is an ex-officion member of the Presbyterian Central New Mexico Community Board of Trustees.
