On November 12, 2018, President Donald J Trump Issued a Presidential Major Disaster Declaration. We request that the relief provided by the Internal Revenue Service in CA-2018-13 under IRC 7508A and Regulation 301.7508A-1 be applied to the reporting organization. The system experienced a catastrophic loss to the hospital in Paradise and multiple other buildings. Included in that loss was the building that housed critical information technology infrastructure. The morning following the start of the fire, the information technology area experienced system-wide loss of service over the following two weeks. The IT

The morning following the start of the fire, the information technology area experienced system-wide loss of service over the following two weeks. The IT function had to make changes to accommodate the losses to infrastructure due to the fire. Tax software was not functional through November 30, 2018. During 2017 the system transitioned to an Enterprise Resource Planning cloud-based system and adopted a shared services model. This change resulted in the loss of personnel knowledgeable about the organizational structure, activities, and financial reporting of the entity. The ability to aggregate data consistent with prior years' reporting was challenging. More time was required to ensure reporting was in alignment with the tax format. Inquiry and reassignment of accounts was needed as we became aware of the constraints in the new ERP environment from within which we obtained the reporting data. Rebalancing of the income statement and net assets was critical and took extensive effort to complete.
