The Foundation may invite certain organizations which do not fall within our focus areas to apply for grants.

The Foundation generally does not support general operating expenses, deficit budgets, general fundraising campaigns, religious purposes, individuals, trips and tours, and charities that redistribute funds to other charitable organizations, except in the case of recognized United Waytype organizations. Requests are limited to one per year per organization.
