One member is elected from each state association and nominated to the board of NRWA. The membership then votes on the nominees at the annual business meeting that is held each fall.

7b. The membership is required by the By-Laws of NRWA to approve all By-Law changes that come before the governing board.

11b. The Form 990 is reviewed by the Finance Committee which consists of members of the governing board. Each member is sent a copy by e-mail and once filed it is posted to the private website specifically for the NRWA Board of Directors. The Form 990 is also reviewed by the auditors as part of the annual audit.

12c. The policy is for board members and is posted on the board's private website and reviewed annually by the Program Review Committee of the Board of Directors. This committee oversees such policies of the organization.

15b. The CEO is evaluated by each member of the Board and then the CEO Evaluation Committee, consisting of the President, Senior Vice President and Vice President, review the evaluations and do a formal evaluation with the CEO. This committee will recommend salary adjustments. The recommendation will then be voted on by the Board. The committee will use outside survey's of like organizations to determine the annual adjustment.
