These entities are not private foundations. This exemption does not apply to unrelated business income (UBI), as defined by Section 512(a)(1) of the Code, which is subject to federal income tax. The University had no material tax liability resulting from such UBI in 2018 or 2017. Universidad Liceo Cervantino is a Mexican non-profit corporation acquired by UIW International on June 4, 2015. U.S. GAAP requires management to evaluate uncertain tax positions taken by the University. The financial statement effects of a tax position are recognized when the position is more likely than not, based on the technical merits, to be sustained upon examination by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) or Treasury. Management has analyzed the tax positions taken by the University and has concluded that as of May 31, 2018, there are no uncertal in positions taken or expected to be taken. The University has recognized no interest or penalties related to uncertain tax positions. The university is subject to routine audits by taxing jurisdictions.
