During the 2017-2018 school year, Riverdale students participated in numerous global and domestic travel opportunities. Over spring break, Middle Schoolers took part in a ten-day Spanish exchange, while Upper Schoolers traveled to South Africa & Namibia, St Petersburg, Russia, Rome, Italy, and Bears Ears National Monument in Utah as part of an outdoor expedition. 
