Bylaws (as restated effective July1, 2017)

ARTICLE I

NAME, PURPOSE, REGISTERED OFFICE, AND FISCAL YEAR

<u>Section 1.1 -- Name.</u> The name of the corporation is United Lutheran Seminary Endowment Foundation (the "Corporation").

- Section 1.2 -- Purpose. The Corporation is incorporated to engage exclusively in charitable, scientific, literary and educational activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any successor United States Internal Revenue law) (the "Code"). More specifically, the Corporation is organized to:
- 1.2.1 encourage and motivate the making of gifts and donations by deed, will, or otherwise, for the advancement, promotion, extension, and maintenance of the various causes and objects fostered as enumerated in the bylaws and articles of incorporation of the United Lutheran Seminary (the "Seminary") and undertake other activities in support of the general purposes of the Seminary;
 - 1.2.2 conduct public fund-raising activities on behalf of the Seminary;
- 1.2.3 invest the funds it raises and serve as an endowment fund for the Seminary;
- 1.2.4 hold title to and manage property that is donated to, or for the benefit of, the endowment fund of the Seminary; and
- 1.2.5 benefit, perform the functions of, or carry out the purposes of (all within the meaning of Code Section 509(a) (3)), the Seminary.

<u>Section 1.3 -- Registered Office.</u> The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be located at 61 Seminary Ridge, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania 17325. The Corporation may also have offices at such other places, within or without Pennsylvania, as the Board of Directors may from time to time appoint or the business of the Corporation may require.

<u>Section 1.4 -- Fiscal Year.</u> The fiscal year of the Corporation shall end on the last day of June.

ARTICLE II

MEMBERSHIP

Section 2.1 -- Member. Membership in the Corporation shall be limited to one class and only one Member. The sole member of the corporation shall be United Lutheran Seminary (the "Sole Member"). The Sole Member shall have the rights set forth in the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988, as amended, except as provided otherwise in the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation or the Bylaws of the Corporation. The interest of the Sole Member shall be non-assignable.

Section 2.2 -- Powers. In addition to all of the matters required by law or by other provisions of these Bylaws to be approved by the Sole Member of the Corporation, the Sole Member may initiate and implement any proposal with respect to any of the following, and if any proposal with respect to any of the following is otherwise initiated, it shall not become effective unless approved by the Sole Member of the Corporation. For purposes of these Bylaws, matters shall be "approved by the Sole Member" acting through its Board of Trustees in regular or special session or by the Executive Committee of its Board of Trustees when its Board of Trustees is not in session.

- 2.2.1 The election or removal at any time and without cause of any director of the Corporation;
- 2.2.2 Any alteration, amendment or repeal of or to the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws of the Corporation;
- 2.2.3 Any unbudgeted borrowing, encumbering of assets, or any capital expenditures in excess of such amount as the Sole Member may designate from time to time, or any other action not in the ordinary course of the Corporation's activities;

2.2.4 Approval of the Corporation's strategic plans; and

2.2.5 Approval of the sale, purchase, lease or encumbrance with debt in any way, of real property of the Corporation in excess of such amount as the Sole Member may designate from time to time.

Section 2.3 -- Annual Meeting. The annual meeting of the Sole Member of the Corporation shall be held in October of each year on the business day before the date fixed by the Sole Member for the October meeting of its Board of Trustees, at the registered office of the Corporation, or at such other date and place as may be fixed by the Board of Directors. Written notice of the annual meeting shall be given at least seven days prior to the date named for the meeting.

ARTICLE III BOARD OF DIRECTORS

<u>Section 3.1 -- Number of Directors.</u> The Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be composed of not less than five (5) nor more than thirty (30) Directors, who shall be elected in accordance with this Article. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased in the same manner as these Bylaws may be amended.

Section 3.2 -- Election and Term of Directors.

3.2.1 Directors shall be elected by the Board of Trustees of the Sole Member at the Sole Member's annual meeting from a slate of candidates nominated by the Board of Directors of the Corporation and submitted to the Sole Member or upon nomination. Each director of the Corporation shall be a natural person of full age. The Directors shall be divided into three (3) classes, which shall be equal or approximately equal in size. The term of each of the three classes of directors shall be three years and shall be arranged so that the term of one-third of the Directors, as nearly as may be, shall expire at each annual meeting of the Corporation. Each director shall hold office until the expiration of the term of the class of director to which he or she is assigned and until his or her successor shall have been elected and qualified, or until his or her earlier death, resignation or removal. One group of directors shall be elected each year.

3.2.2 The President and the Chief Advancement Officer (or her or his designee) of the Sole Member shall serve as ex-officio directors of the Corporation.

<u>Section 3.3 -- Vacancies.</u> Vacancies occurring on the Board due to death, resignation or removal may be filled by the Sole Member.

Section 3.4 -- Resignation or Removal and Attendance Requirements.

- 3.4.1 A Director may resign at any time by tendering his or her resignation in writing to the Chair of the Board or the Secretary, which shall become effective upon receipt.
- 3.4.2 Directors are expected to attend and participate in all Board meetings unless unavoidably prevented from doing so.
- 3.4.3 Resignation or removal as a Director shall also constitute resignation or removal as an officer and as a member of any committee of the Board.

Section 3.5 -- Personal Liability of Directors.

- 3.5.1 General Rule. A Director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable for monetary damages for any action taken or any failure to take any action, except to the extent that exemption from liability for monetary damages is not permitted under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as now or hereafter in effect. The provisions of this subsection 3.5.1 are intended to exempt the Directors of the Corporation from liability for monetary damages to the maximum extent permitted under any Pennsylvania law now or hereafter in effect.
- 3.5.2 Specific Rule Under Directors' Liability Act. Without limitation of subsection 3.5.1 above, a director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable for monetary damages for any action taken or any failure to take any action, unless: (i) the director has breached or failed to perform the duties of his office, and (ii) the breach or failure to perform constitutes self-dealing, willful misconduct or recklessness. The provisions of the preceding sentence shall not exempt a director from: (i) the responsibility or liability of a director pursuant to any criminal statute; or (ii) the liability of a director for the payment of taxes pursuant to local, state or federal law.
- 3.5.3 <u>Modification or Repeal.</u> The provisions of this section may be modified or repealed in accordance with the procedures for amending these Bylaws; provided, however, that any such modification or repeal shall not have any effect upon the liability of a director relating to any action taken, any failure to take any action, or events which occurred prior to the effective date of such modification or repeal.
 - 3.5.4 Compensation of Directors and Committee Members. Directors and

members of committees shall receive no compensation for services rendered in those capacities. However, nothing contained herein shall be construed to preclude any Director from receiving compensation from the Corporation for other services actually rendered or for expenses incurred for serving the Corporation in any other capacity.

A R T I C L E I V MEETINGS OF THE BOARD

<u>Section 4.1 -- Regular Meetings.</u> Regular meetings of the Board shall be held not less often than annually at such place and time as shall be designated by the Board.

<u>Section 4.2 -- Special Meetings.</u> Special meetings of the Board may be called at any time by the Chair of the Board or the President, and shall be called upon receipt of the written request of any two or more Trustees

Section 4.3 -- Notice of Board Meetings. Directors shall be given written notice of each meeting of the Board setting forth the time and place of the meeting and the matters of business to be transacted. Such notice shall be delivered to each director either personally or by mail, telegram, express delivery, telefacsimile or electronic mail to his or her residence or place of business as listed in the Corporation's records not less than five days prior to such meeting. Business to be transacted at any regular meeting of the Board shall not be limited to those matters set forth in the notice of meeting. Notice of any meeting of the Board may be waived by the execution of a written waiver of such notice, either before or after the holding of such meeting by any director. Such waiver shall be filed with or entered upon the records of the meeting. The attendance of any Director at any meeting without protest at the commencement of the meeting shall be deemed to be a waiver of notice of the meeting.

Section 4.4 -- Quorum. A majority of the directors of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The act of a majority of the Directors present and voting at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board. After a quorum has been established at a meeting of the Board, the subsequent withdrawal of directors from the meeting so as to reduce the number of directors present to fewer than the number required for a quorum shall not affect the validity of any action taken by the Board at the meeting or any adjournment thereof. Notice of any such adjourned meeting shall be given to the directors who are not present at the time of adjournment.

Section 4.5 -- Board and Board Committee Action without a Meeting. Any action which may

be taken at a meeting of the Board or a Board committee may be taken without a meeting if, prior to such action, a consent in writing setting forth such action is signed by all of the members of the Board or committee, as the case may be, and is filed in the minutes of the proceedings of the Board or of the committee. The written consent of the President of the Sole Member shall not be required for action to be considered taken without a meeting.

Section 4.6 -- Use of Conference Telephone and Similar Equipment. One or more persons may participate in a meeting of the Board of Directors, or any committee of the Board of Directors, by means of conference telephone, videoconference, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other. Participation in meeting pursuant to this Section shall constitute presence in person at the meeting and shall count towards any quorum requirements.

<u>Section 4.7 -- Minutes.</u> Minutes of each meeting of the Board shall be taken by the Secretary or his or her designee and be disseminated to each trustee as soon as practicable after the conclusion of the meeting.

ARTICLE V OFFICERS

Section 5.1 -- Officers. The Officers of the Corporation shall consist of the Chair of the Board, the President, the Vice President, the Secretary, the Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board shall deem advisable, each of whom shall be elected by the Board at its annual meeting. Such Officers shall hold office for the term of one year, or until their successors are elected and qualified except in the event of their earlier death, resignation or removal. Unless otherwise specified in these Bylaws, Officers of the Corporation are not required to be trustees. One person may hold two or more offices, except those of Chair and Secretary.

<u>Section 5.2 -- Vacancies.</u> A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation or removal shall be filled by the Board for the unexpired term of such office.

<u>Section 5.3 -- Resignation or Removal of Officers.</u> An Officer of the Corporation may resign at any time by tendering a resignation in writing to the Chair or Secretary. The resignation shall become effective immediately upon receipt. An Officer may be removed at any time with or without cause by a vote of a majority of the whole number of the Directors at any meeting of the

Board.

Section 5.4 -- Chair of the Board. The Chair of the Board shall be a director, and shall preside

at all meetings of the Board. He or she shall appoint all committees (except for the Executive

Committee) and their chair in accordance with these Bylaws. He or she shall have such

other duties and responsibilities as shall be delegated to him or her by these Bylaws and by the

Board from time to time.

Section 5.5 -- President. The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the

Corporation, shall attend all regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors, and shall

have such other duties and responsibilities as the Board shall deem advisable.

Section 5.6 - - Vice President. The Vice President shall act in all cases for and as the President

in the absence or incapacity of the President and shall perform such other duties as are delegated or

required to be performed.

Section 5.7 -- Secretary. The Secretary shall cause to be kept all of the records of the

Corporation except the financial records, shall cause to be recorded the minutes of the meetings of

the Board, shall ensure that all notices of meetings are sent out, attest to the seal of the

Corporation where necessary or required, and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by

the Board or the Chairman of the Board. The Secretary shall also keep or cause to be kept a

current register of the names and addresses of each member and each Board member.

Section 5.8 -- Treasurer. The Treasurer shall insure that a true and accurate accounting of the

financial transactions of the Corporation is made and that such accounting is presented to and made

available to the Board.

Section 5.9 -- Other Officers. The Board by resolution may appoint one or more Vice

Chairs, Assistant Secretaries or Assistant Treasurers and such other Officers having such duties

and responsibilities as the Board shall deem advisable. Such Officers, other than any Vice

Chairs, need not be members of the Board.

ARTICLE VI

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

7

Section 6.1 -- Appointment. Except as otherwise provided in this Article VI, or in a resolution of the Board creating a committee, the Chair of the Board shall appoint the members and the chairs of such committees as the Board may create pursuant to these Bylaws. The chairs of all committees of the Board of Directors shall be members of the Board of Directors. Unless otherwise specified in these Bylaws, committee members may include persons other than Board members.

<u>Section 6.2 -- Committee Members' Term of Office.</u> Committee members shall be initially appointed for a one (1) year term. Each member of a committee shall continue in office from the time of his or her appointment and until his or her successor is appointed unless the committee of which he or she is a member shall be sooner terminated by the Board, or until his or her death, resignation or removal, whichever first occurs.

Section 6.3- Committee Meetings. Meetings of any committee of the Board may be called by the chair of such committee by giving notice of such meeting, setting forth its time and place and delivered personally or by mail, express delivery, telefacsimile or telephone to the residence or place of business of the member as listed in the Corporation's records at least five days prior to such meeting. Unless otherwise provided in these Bylaws, a majority of the members of any committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. After a quorum has been established at a committee meeting, the subsequent withdrawal of committee members from the meeting so as to reduce the number of committee members present to fewer than the number required for a quorum shall not affect the validity of any action taken at the meeting. Each committee shall keep minutes of its meetings and report to the Board as necessary with recommendations.

Section 6.4 -- Resignation or Removal of Committee Members. A member of any committee of the Board may resign at any time by tendering his or her resignation in writing to the Chair of the Board or the Secretary. The Board may, by majority vote, remove any member from a committee of the Board, with or without cause.

Section 6.5- Executive Committee.

6.5.1. The Board of Directors shall have an Executive Committee, the members of which shall

be the Chair (who shall be the Chair of the Executive Committee), the President and the Vice President of the Corporation; the President of the Sole Member and two at-large members elected by the Board of Directors who shall be directors of the Corporation. Such members shall hold their seats on the Executive Committee for a term of one year and shall be subject to those provisions in these Bylaws which relate to officers of the Corporation in general.

- 6.5.2. Between regular meetings of the Board of Directors, the Executive Committee may discharge the duties of the Board and shall also perform all other duties committed to it by the Board. The Executive Committee shall have and may exercise all of the powers and authority of the Board of Directors, except it shall not have any power or authority as to the following:
 - (a) The submission to the Sole Member of any action required by statute to be submitted to the members of a corporation for their approval.
 - (b) The filling of vacancies in the Board of Directors.
 - (c) The adoption, amendment or repeal of the Bylaws.
 - (d) The amendment or repeal of any resolution of the Board.

Under emergency conditions and upon a unanimous roll call vote, the Executive Committee shall have the power and authority (a) to temporarily suspend the execution of resolutions of the Board; and (b) to temporarily fill vacancies in the Board of Directors, such action being subject to ratification by the Board of Directors.

- 6.5.3. The call for a meeting of the Executive Committee may be made by the Chair or President who shall determine the time and place of the meeting. Notice shall be provided at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. Telecommunications may be used in the conduct of the meeting.
- 6.5.4. A majority of the members of the Executive Committee in office shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The acts of a majority of the members of the Executive Committee present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the acts of the Executive Committee, except, upon the objection of any two members of the Executive Committee, a matter under consideration shall not be acted upon by the Executive Committee but shall instead be referred to a regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors as determined by the Executive Committee.
 - 6.5.5. The Executive Committee shall report all business conducted to the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VII

GENERAL

Section 7.1 -- Seal. The Board may adopt, use and thereafter alter a corporate seal.

Section 7.2 -- Execution of Instruments.

7.2.1 The Board, except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances. Unless so authorized, no officer, agent, or employee shall have any power or authority to bind the Corporation by any contract or engagement or to pledge its credit or to render it liable pecuniarily for any purpose or in any amount.

7.2.2 Unless otherwise specifically determined by the Board or otherwise required by law, formal contracts of the Corporation, promissory notes, deeds of trust, mortgages and other evidences of indebtedness of the Corporation, and other corporate instruments or documents shall be executed, signed or endorsed by the President or the Vice President and by the Secretary or the Treasurer, or by any other officer or agent of the Corporation to whom the Board, by resolution, shall have delegated such power, and may have the corporate seal affixed thereto.

Section 7.3 -- Other Fiscal Matters.

- 7.3.1 All funds of the Corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation with such banks, bankers, trust companies, or other depositories as the Board may select or as may be selected by any officer or officers, agent or agents of the Corporation to whom such power may be delegated from time to time by the Board.
- 7.3.2 Endorsements for deposit of commercial paper to the credit of the Corporation in any of depositories may be made, without countersignature, by the Chair, the President, the Vice President, the Treasurer or Assistant Treasurer, or by any other officer or agent of the Corporation to whom the Board, by resolution, shall have delegated such power, or by hand stamped impression in the name of the Corporation.
- 7.3.3 All checks, drafts, or other order for payment of money, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness, issued in the name of or payable to the Corporation, shall be signed or endorsed by such person or persons and in such manner as shall be determined from time to time by

resolution of the Board.

<u>Section 7.4 Annual Report,</u> The Board of Directors shall present annually to the Sole Member a report covering the activities of the Corporation for the past year and showing in appropriate detail the following:

- 7.4.1 The assets and liabilities, including the trust funds, of the Corporation as of the end of the fiscal year immediately preceding the date of the report.
- 7.4.2 The principal changes in assets and liabilities, during the year immediately preceding the date of the report.
- 7.4.3 The revenue or receipts of the Corporation, restricted to particular purposes, for the year immediately preceding the date of the report, including separate data with respect to each trust fund held by or for the Corporation.
- 7.4.4 The expenses or disbursements of the Corporation, for both general and restricted purposes, during the year immediately preceding the date of the report, including separate data with respect to each trust fund held by or for the Corporation.

The annual report shall be filed with the minutes of the meetings of the Sole Member and shall be distributed to the Board of Directors of the Sole Member.

<u>Section 7.5 -- Construction.</u> Words used herein in the masculine shall include the feminine, in the singular shall include the plural and in the plural shall include the singular unless the context indicates otherwise.

Section 7.6 -- Conflicts of Interest.

- 7.6.1 <u>Duty to Disclose</u>. Directors and officers shall have an affirmative duty to disclose in a timely fashion to the Board the material facts relative to any relationship or interest, financial or otherwise, which they, or any other corporation, partnership, association or other organization in which they have any interest, may have in any contract or transaction to which this Corporation is or is about to become a party.
 - 7.6.2 Bylaws; Certification. Directors and officers shall acknowledge receipt of a

copy of the Bylaws of this Corporation and by serving as a Director certify that they have no conflict of interest which requires disclosure to the Board under this Article VII which has not been disclosed.

<u>Section 7.7 Parliamentary Authority</u>. The parliamentary authority for meetings of the Corporation shall be the current edition of *Roberts Rules of Order*.

ARTICLE VIII

INDEMNIFICATION

Section 8.1 -- General Rule. Subject to the provisions of the immediately following sentence, the Corporation shall, to the fullest extent permitted under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as now or hereafter in effect, indemnify any person (and his or her heirs, executors and administrators) who was or is a party, witness or other participant or is threatened to be made a party, witness or participant to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative (including, without limitation, actions by or in the right of the Corporation) by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a director, officer, committee member acting on behalf of the Corporation, employee or agent of the Corporation, or is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, trustee, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against all expenses (including attorneys' fees, court costs, transcript costs, fees of experts and witnesses, travel expenses and all other similar expenses), judgments, fines, penalties and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such action, suit or proceeding. Indemnification shall not be provided in any case where the conduct giving rise to the claim for indemnification constituted willful misconduct, recklessness or self-dealing.

Section 8.2 -- Advance Payment of Expenses. The Corporation shall advance all reasonable expenses (including attorneys' fees, court costs, transcript costs, fees of experts and witnesses, travel expenses and all other similar expenses) reasonably incurred in connection with the defense of or other response to any action, suit or proceeding referred to above upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the person seeking the advance to repay all amounts advanced if it shall ultimately be determined upon final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding that he is not entitled to be indemnified by the Corporation.

Section 8.3 -- No Duplication of Payments. The Corporation shall not be liable under this

section to make any payment of amounts otherwise indemnifiable hereunder if and to the extent that the person seeking indemnification has otherwise actually received payment therefor under any insurance policy, contract, agreement or otherwise. In the event that the Corporation makes an advance payment of expenses to a person, such person shall repay to the Corporation the amount so advanced, if and to the extent that he or she subsequently receives payment therefor under any insurance policy, contract, agreement or otherwise.

Section 8.4 -- Insurance. The Corporation may purchase and maintain at its own expense one or more policies of insurance to protect itself and to protect any director, officer, member of a committee acting on behalf of the Corporation, employee or agent of the Corporation or of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise against any expense, liability or loss incurred by such person in such capacity, whether or not the Corporation would have the authority to indemnify such person against any such expense, liability or loss under this section or under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 8.5 -- Indemnification Agreements. The Corporation shall have authority by vote of a majority of the Board of Directors to enter into an Indemnification Agreement with any person who may be indemnified by the Corporation pursuant to the provisions of this section or otherwise. Any such Indemnification Agreement may contain such terms and conditions, including provisions to secure the indemnification obligations set forth in this Article, as a majority of the Board of Directors shall in the exercise of their discretion determine to be necessary or appropriate. Such terms and conditions may include provisions for greater or lesser indemnification than provided for in this section, provisions establishing procedures for the processing or approval of indemnification claims, and other provisions to the extent permitted by law. The fact that the Corporation has not entered into an Indemnification Agreement with any person shall not in any way limit the indemnification rights of such person under this section or otherwise.

Section 8.6 -- Non-exclusively. The right to indemnification and to the payment of expenses incurred in defending against or otherwise responding to any action, suit or proceeding in advance of its final disposition as set forth in this article shall not be exclusive of any other rights which any person may now have or hereafter acquire under any agreement, vote of shareholders, vote of disinterested Directors, or under any applicable law or under the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, or otherwise.

Section 8.7 -- Survival of Rights. The indemnification rights provided to a person under the provisions of this article shall continue after such person ceases to be a director, officer, member of a committee acting on behalf of the Corporation, employee or agent of the Corporation or of another entity, as to any action taken, any failure to take action, or any events which occurred while such person was a director, officer, employee or agent of the Corporation or of another entity.

<u>Section 8.8 -- Modification or Repeal.</u> The provisions of this article may be modified or repealed in accordance with the procedures for amending these Bylaws; provided, however, that any such modification or repeal shall not have any effect upon the indemnification rights of any person as they relate to any action taken, any failure to take action, or events which occurred prior to the effective date of such modification or repeal.

A R T I C L E I X DISSOLUTION AND LIQUIDATION

Upon the dissolution and/or liquidation of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all assets of the Corporation to the Sole Member or if the Sole Member is no longer in existence, to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Code Section 501(c)(3), as the Board of Directors shall determine.

A R T I C L E X AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws and the Articles of Incorporation may be altered, amended, repealed or supplemented, and new Bylaws or Articles of Incorporation may be adopted only by the Sole Member. Recommendations for alterations, amendments, supplements or repeal of the Bylaws may be made by a majority vote of the Board of Directors of this Corporation at any regular or special meeting of the Board duly convened after notice to the Board of Directors for that purpose or by unanimous written consent of all members of the Board of Directors without a meeting.
