



PINNACLE HEALTH MEDICAL SERVICES (PHMS) IS A TAX EXEMPT ENTITY THAT IS PRIMARILY ENGAGED IN THE PROVISION OF PHYSICIAN SERVICES. THE PHYSICIAN SERVICES PROVIDED WITHIN PHMS SUPPORT AND ENHANCE THE SERVICES OF UPMC PINNACLE HOSPITALS AND THE UPMC PINNACLE SYSTEM. IT PROVIDES FIRST CLASS PREVENTATIVE CARE TO THE COMMUNITY AS WELL AS COLLABORATES WITH ITS AFFILIATES TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF HEALTHCARE, AND THE PATIENT'S EXPERIENCE.

PHMS HAD 25 VOLUNTEERS THAT PROVIDED VARIOUS DONATED SERVICES DURING THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2018, PHMS PROVIDED FREE CARE DURING THE YEAR TO 1,136 PATIENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$454,670.
