

The completed disclosure shall be maintained in confidence and access shall be limited to persons who have a reasonable need to know the contents. At the time of hiring, a copy of the Policy shall be distributed to all Employees. In addition, a conflict of interest disclosure shall be maintained in confidence and access shall be limited to persons who have a reasonable need to know the contents.
