Part II - As we account on a cash basis, have no capital, no liabilities and no assets other than cash, we do not prepare a balance sheet. Many members pay their dues for the coming program year in the late spring, resulting in typically high cash balances at the end of the June 30 Fiscal Year.

Part III - Affiliated with the World Affairs Council of America, the purpose of the 1100 member WACHH is to inform and educate its members and the broader community about foreign policy issues.

To accomplish these objectives, WACHH has two core programs. A Lecture Series for the membership, and for community members who pay a guest fee, and an Outreach program for the general community and the Public School System.

The lectures are held roughly twice a month from October through May and offer WACHH members and their guests an extensive program on foreign affairs, economic and national security issues through presentations by distinguished practitioners, academics and government, business and military leaders. This year we had 14 such events with an average attendance greater than 600. There are also member discussion groups and educational Forums.

The Outreach program has two components. The first is focused in our public high schools and includes The Academic World Quest, a national competition for students in world affairs sponsored by the World Affairs Council of America; A model UN Program in a local High School and presentations and discussion groups in the schools led by our members. The second is a series of lectures and discussion groups, led by our members and open to the general public.
