# AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF UNIVERSITY OF PROVIDENCE (Fifth Restatement)

The following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (Fifth Restatement) were duly adopted at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the University of Great Falls, a Montana corporation, held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017, upon receiving an affirmative vote of a majority of the Trustees in office:

### **ARTICLE I**

The name of this corporation is University of Providence ("University" or "Corporation").

### ARTICLE II

The Corporation is a public benefit corporation. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE III

The purposes for which this Corporation is organized are:

- a) To further the higher education of men and women through the provision of quality curricula in liberal and general education combined with career and professional preparation which are aimed at developing the full potential of the student and to confer appropriate degrees, certificates and diplomas upon completion of such curricula as may be established by the University in accordance with the provisions of its Articles of Incorporation and the laws of the State of Montana. These educational purposes are pursued within a scholarly and Christian environment in the Roman Catholic tradition and keeping with the continuing mission and values of Providence Health & Services and guided by the tradition and charism of the Sisters of Providence;
- b) To purchase, receive, acquire and to own, hold, enjoy and to sell, convey, mortgage, pledge and otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every kind and description, and to accept and receive and administer donations, grants, gifts, bequests, devises and contributions for any of the purposes herein mentioned; and
- c) To do anything and everything lawful and permissible in order to carry out any of the foregoing, and to exercise every right and power now or hereafter granted to nonprofit corporations under the laws of Montana, provided that the powers granted hereunder shall be exercised exclusively for the purposes designated in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law.

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RESTATED ARTICLES

### **ARTICLE IV**

The Corporation shall have one Member: Providence Health & Services ("Providence"), a Washington nonprofit corporation. The Member shall have the rights set forth in the Bylaws.

### ARTICLE V

The Corporation's business and affair shall be managed by a board of directors, which shall be referred to as the Board of Trustees. The number of Trustees constituting the initial Board of Trustees was five (5). The number of Trustees and the methods for their designation, election or appointment shall be as provided in the Bylaws, provided that in no event shall provision be made therein for less than three (3) Trustees. In the absence of a Bylaw fixing the number of Trustees, the number of Trustees shall be three (3). The procedure for removal of a Trustee shall be as provided in the Bylaws.

### **ARTICLE VI**

The registered office of the Corporation is at the City of Great Falls, Montana at 1301 20<sup>th</sup> Street South, on the campus of University of Providence, and the registered agent of the Corporation at the time of adoption of these Restated Articles of Incorporation (Fifth Restatement) is Eugene J. McAllister.

### ARTICLE VII

The Corporation shall be a no-stock corporation and shall be nonprofit in character. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its Trustees, officers or other private persons or organizations, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. Upon any dissolution or final liquidation of this Corporation, or should this Corporation cease to operate as a liberal arts university having the objectives stated in Article III hereof, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation to Providence, its sole corporate Member, or to its designee, provided that such recipient entity is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, and qualifies as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code ("Code")(or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). If, at the time of dissolution, Providence is not in existence, is not an exempt organization under the Code, or makes no such designation, the Board of Trustees shall dispose of all the corporate assets to Providence Ministries or its designee, provided that such recipient entity is still in existence and organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, and qualifies as an exempt organization under the Code If, at the time of dissolution, Providence Ministries is not in existence, is not an exempt organization under the Code, or makes no such designation, the Board of Trustees shall dispose of all the corporate assets to any other organization(s) selected by the Sisters of Providence, General Administration, Montreal, provided that each such recipient entity is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and qualifies as an exempt organization under the Code.

### **ARTICLE VIII**

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (Fifth Restatement) supersede the heretofore existing Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation and any and all amendments thereto or restatements thereof.

The above Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (Fifth Restatement) correctly set forth without change the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as heretofore amended and restated. These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (Fifth Restatement) contain amendments unanimously adopted by the Member of the Corporation at a meeting held March 8, 2017 to be effective as of 11:59 pm on March 8, 2017.
