Under the policy, each Board of Director, officer, and standing committee member must file the annual certification statement, at or immediately following the annual meeting of the Foundation. This statement must set forth any conflicts of interest that might be expected to occur within the coming year. The statement shall disclose as fully as possible the nature of the potential conflicts and the nature of the individuals' (or their family

members') interest in the potential transactions. All statements that anticipate conflicts of interest are then circulated to the full Board. In the interim, if any Board of Director or committee member or member of his/her family has or is about to assume an interest or other r'elationship which might result in a conflict of interest, it is the Board of Director's or committee member's responsibility to immediately disclose all material facts to the chair of the Board of Directors or the Chair of the Audit Committee. This conflict of interest process is managed by the internal Foundation Board Relations team which tracks and monitors submission of the annual certification statements and processes instances where a conflict is identified.

If a Responsible Person is aware that the WSU Foundation is about to enter into any transaction or make any decision involving a conflict of interest (a "Conflicting Interest Transaction") such person shall: (i) immediately inform those charged with approving the Conflicting Interest Transaction on behalf of the WSU Foundation of the interest or position of such person or any party related to such person; (ii) and the persons charged with making the decision by disclosing any material facts within the Responsible Person's knowledge that bear on the advisability of the WSU Foundation entering into the Conflicting Interest Transaction; and (iii) not be entitled to vote on the decision to enter into such transaction.
