Every dollar we raise is extremely valuable so we can keep helping these students participate It is operated entirely by volunteers and over the last three years there has been a high amount of turnover in officers. Information about who filed our taxes and whether or not they were filed was not passed down to our current treasurer. Our current treasurer attempted to hire a tax person for 2018 taxes An extension was filed for the 2018 tax year. However it was not filed because of Covid 19 and the treasurer was unable to contact the tax man In December 2020 after becoming aware of this issue, Mrs. Michelle Weinmaster, our President along with the volunteer board met and reviewed all booster club records and documents. It was at that time, she filed an extension for 2019 and began collecting the necessary documents for 2017, 2018 and 2019 Policies have been updated to make sure taxes are filed properly in the future. The board has also invested in an online Money minder software that has the ability to help with the 990ez form instead of using excel. On December 29, 2020 the form 990ezs for 2017, 2018 and 2019 were completed Based on the above facts, we are asking that the penalties be abated in full.
