**bloom!:** Offers innovative, emergent learning experiences for childcare center, private preschool and public school professionals. bloom! focuses on quality interactions based upon the principles of child development. bloom! serves at least three early education organizations and a public school through intense mentoring on children's needs in early education environments. bloom! works with 10 school administrators, eight (early education) directors, 96 (early education) teachers who are improving interactions with 850 children producing quality learning environments for children birth – 6 years. bloom! is working with a local community (Garrett, IN) to form a model school for university students to study, teachers (early education and elementary education) to learn and children to prosper.

bloom! makes use of two bloom! mentors and a publication, 7 Simple Ideas to Make Your Classroom Bloom!, along with sustainability consulting services.

**Youth Pods:** Empowers 212 adolescence-aged young people as grantmakers; who give time, talent and treasury to the issues that young people believe are most important in their local community. This initiative has a leadership team of high school and college students who facilitate workshops and retreats to provide education to their philanthropic peers. In past years the leadership team hosted a retreat for the all the young people involved in Youth Pods. During 2018, the foundation made the decision to hand the leadership for Youth Pods over to local community foundations. The (youth) leadership team is disbanding over the next year and will no longer host retreats in the same manner going forward.

Nine community foundations within four states are partners in the Youth Pod concept along with 47 school districts and a youth leadership team of 9 students.
