AS SUCH, THE DISTRIBUTIONS MADE BY THE FOUNDATION FROM TRUST INCOME ARE ADJUSTED FROM THE FOUNDATION'S QUALIFYING DISTRIBUTIONS AS A DISTRIBUTION FROM CORPUS PURSUANT TO 53.4942(A)-3(D)(2).
