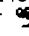

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


THROUGH THE HOSPITAL'S AFFILIATION WITH TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER, THE HOSPITAL CONDUCTS PEDIATRIC RESEARCH AND EDUCATION, AND SERVES AS A TEACHING HOSPITAL FOR THE TEXAS TECH RESIDENCY PROGRAM. THE HOSPITAL HAS FOUR FULL-TIME TEXAS MEDICAID HEALTHCARE PARTNERSHIP (TMHP) PERSONNEL LOCATED IN THE BUILDING TO ENSURE THAT EVERY ELIGIBLE PATIENT IS ENROLLED IN CHIP-TEXAS WHICH IS SPECIFICALLY LEGISLATED TO PROVIDE MEDICAID-LIKE COVERAGE TO CHILDREN EVEN IF THEIR PARENTS DO NOT QUALIFY. THE LARGE MAJORITY OF CHILDREN CAN BE ENROLLED IN SOME TYPE OF GOVERNMENT PROGRAM. AS A RESULT, ONLY A VERY FEW CASES REMAIN IN THE TRADITIONAL CATEGORY OF CHARITY.
