LEADERSHIP'S SUPPORT, CONCLUDED THAT PRISMA HEALTH-UPSTATE COULD HAVE THE MOST SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE, SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH, OBESITY/NUTRITIONAL HEALTH, AND MENTAL/BEHAVIORAL HEALTH. PRISMA HEALTH-UPSTATE HAS RESOURCES AND PROGRAMS ALREADY IN PLACE THAT THROUGH EXPANSION AND ENHANCEMENT COULD SUPPORT AND POSITIVELY INFLUENCE THESE ISSUES. HEART DISEASE MORTALITY, DIABETES, AND CANCER MORTALITY WERE NOT SELECTED AS FOCUS AREAS BUT PRISMA HEALTH-UPSTATE HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO AFFECT THESE ISSUES INDIRECTLY BY FOCUSING ON OBESITY/NUTRITIONAL HEALTH. THERE IS A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF RESEARCH INDICATING THAT OBESITY AND POOR NUTRITION NEGATIVELY INFLUENCE ALL THREE OF THESE HEALTH ISSUES. BY FOCUSING EFFORTS ON INCREASING HEALTHY EATING AND ACTIVE LIVING AND BY ADDRESSING FOOD INSECURITY, RISKS FOR CHRONIC DISEASES WILL BE REDUCED. ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE AND SUICIDE MORTALITY WERE NOT SELECTED AS FOCUS AREAS BECAUSE SIMILAR TO THE CONNECTION BETWEEN OBESITY AND CHRONIC DISEASE; THERE IS ALSO A CONNECTION BETWEEN MENTAL/BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND SUICIDE. ACTIVITIES CONCENTRATING ON IMPROVING MENTAL/BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES SHOULD ALSO POSITIVELY IMPACT SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND SUICIDE RISKS. UNINTENTIONAL INJURY WAS NOT SELECTED AS A FOCUS AREA BECAUSE THE SYSTEM FEELS IT HAS THE RESOURCES AND EXPERTISE TO HAVE A GREATER IMPACT ON THE FOUR SELECTED PRIORITY AREAS. PRISMA HEALTH-UPSTATE'S CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL HAS BEEN AND WILL CONTINUE LEADING THE SAFE KIDS UPSTATE COALITION, WHICH TEAMS WITH COMMUNITY PARTNERS TO PREVENT UNINTENTIONAL CHILDHOOD INJURY, A LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH OF CHILDREN 19 AND UNDER.
