If it is not clear that the patient/family will have a balance prior to discharge (co-pays, out of pocket etc.) the patient/family will receive information on the Charity Care Program which is noted on the

Schedule H, Part VI, Line 4	As one of the most highly-rated rehabilitation hospital in the United States for spinal cord (SCI) and traumatic brain injuries (TBI), Craig treats patients from virtually every state including some from outside the US Based in Englewood, Colorado, approximately 60% of all patients are from Colorado. The other top five states in order would include Wyoming, New Mexico, Kansas, and California. These five states account for approximately 74% of all patients treated during FY 2018. During FY 2018, Craig treated patients from 37 states. Since becoming a specialty hospital in 1956, Craig has treated over 33,000 patients with an SCI or TBI. With an average of 500 inpatients and 2000 outpatients a year, 51% are SCI patients and 49% BI patients. 
