Our area has no Intended purpose. Tuition grants may be paid directly to the course offerer; funds for books or college supplies generally go directly to the guest, with follow-up by staff. Part III, Line 3 - Small "loans" of \$200 or less are made from time to time to residential guests. Guests are not required to pay back the loan, but sometimes they do. Staff work with families to improve financial literacy, increase "rainy day" savings, and avoid the need for future loans.
