THE 2018 AMENDED FORM 990-PF IDENTIFIED \$847,036 OF UNDISTRIBUTED INCOME ON PART XIII. THIS UNDISTRIBUTED INCOME WAS FUNDED AND PAID BY THE FOUNDATION BY DECEMBER 31, 2019. THE FOUNDATION PROPERLY ELECTED UNDER IRC SECTION 4942(H)(2) AND REGULATION 53.4942(A)-3(D)(2) TO TREAT CURRENT YEAR QUALIFYING DISTRIBUTIONS IN EXCESS OF THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING TAX YEAR'S UNDISTRIBUTED INCOME AS BEING MADE OUT OF UNDISTRIBUTED INCOME FROM PRIOR TAX YEARS.

AS NOTED ON THIS 2019 FORM 990-PF, PART XIII, THERE IS NO LONGER UNDISTRIBUTED INCOME AND \$227,940 OF THE 2019 DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET, LEAVING \$174,100 TO BE DISTRIBUTED BY DECEMBER 31, 2020.
