IEEE's total members was 422,460, from more than 160 countries worldwide, student memberships were 123,508, total IEEE society memberships were 328,558 from 39 IEEE Societies. As part of its growing focus on global public policy, the IEEE Board of Directors adopted multiple position statements in 2018, offering recommendations to policy makers around the world supporting the following topics advancing universal access to the internet, privacy engineering and strong encryption. IEEE also increased activities in public policy activity by the newly formed IEEE European Public Policy Initiative and the IEEE Standards Association's Ethically Aligned Design initiative.
