THE EVALUATION MUST BE SIGNED OFF BY THE BOARD CHAIR WITH THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER. THE SIGNED EVALUATION IS SHARED WITH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND THEN THE ENTIRE BOARD. THE COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS DISCUSSES EVERY TWO YEARS BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. THE BOARD CHAIR RESEARCHES COMPENSATION SURVEYS FROM COMPARABLE AGENCIES WITH COMPARABLE BUDGETS AND SERVICES. DECISIONS ON INCREASED COMPENSATION ARE BASED ON THE FINANCIAL HEALTH OF THE AGENCY. THE INCREASES PAID TO OTHER STAFF AND THE GROWTH THE AGENCY HAS EXPERIENCED OVER THE YEARS. THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S COMPENSATION COMPRISES OF AN ANNUAL SALARY INDIVIDUAL HEALTH CARE AND AN AUTOMOBILE INCLUDING ALL RELATED EXPENSES.
