Explanation:

The Joyce and Irving Goldman Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation") has recently amended its Form 990-PF for the tax years ended December 31, 2014, 2015 and 2016 to correct its Minimum Investment Return calculation in Part X and to re-calculate its undistributed income reported in Part XIII due to the incorrect valuation of certain prior year non-charitable use assets. The returns were also revised to include certain realized capital gains that were omitted from the originally filed returns in addition to certain other minor adjustments.

Since filing its 2017 return, the Foundation has filed Form 4720 accordingly. In accordance with Internal Revenue Code section 4962(a), since the prior inaccuracies described above were due to reasonable cause and not due to willful neglect, the Foundation is currently seeking abatement of the excise tax shown thereon with the Internal Revenue Service. In addition the Foundation had conservatively estimated and paid an amount above and beyond what the revised requirement was in calendar 2018 to account for the prior year deficiencies resulting from the incorrect valuation of assets.
