LI FOUNDATION FELLOWSHIPS

The Li Foundation was founded in 1944 by Kuo Ching Li and his four brothers of the Wah Chang Corporation and incorporated in the sate of New York to promote friendly relationship between the United States and China. Educational interchange was deemed to be the vehicle for achieving this objective and over the years the Foundation has assisted deserving Chinese students and scholars sponsored by selecting institutions for one to two years of study and training in the United States. Grants are not provided directly to individuals but only to nominees of such organizations.

The grant provides \$25,000 annually to cover cost of living, professional expenses, return transportation to china and \$700 to attend a professional meeting.

The Foundation invites academic institutions in the United States and China to join in a sister relationship to sponsor a student or scholar. The institution in the United States is expected to waive tuition costs and encourage the student to return to China. Institutions selected on this program can expect support for five years and can apply for renewal of the grant after the fourth year. Grant applications deadline is February 1 every year.
