WHEN THE TRUST'S OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC IS COMBINED WITH THE OTHER LLC MEMBERS, THE TRUST COULD BE CONSIDERED TO OWN A CONTROLLED ENTITY. DURING THE 2018 TAX YEAR, THE H. SMITH RICHARDSON CHARITABLE TRUST DID NOT RECEIVE ANY SPECIFIED PAYMENTS FROM MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC WITHIN THE MEANING OF INTERNAL REVENUE CODE SECTION 512(B)(13)(A).

ALSO, THE H. SMITH RICHARDSON CHARITABLE TRUST'S OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC IS NOT AN EXCESS BUSINESS HOLDING UNDER INTERNAL REVENUE CODE SECTION 4943.

MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC IS A PARTNERSHIP FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES, AND IT HAS FOUR PARTNERS/LLC MEMBERS. ALL OF THE MEMBERS ARE TAX EXEMPT ENTITIES UNDER INTERNAL REVENUE CODE SECTION 501(C)(3).

THIS LLC WAS FORMED FOR THE PURPOSE OF POOLING EACH INDIVIDUAL TAX EXEMPT ENTITY'S SEPARATE INVESTMENTS INTO ONE LARGER INVESTMENT POOL. THIS POOLING OF INVESTMENTS PROVIDES MANY BENEFITS TO THE PARTNERS/MEMBERS WHICH INCLUDE LOWER INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT FEES AND ACCESS TO INVESTMENTS NOT OTHERWISE AVAILABLE. MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC

DOES NOT HAVE ANY EMPLOYEES AND ITS ONLY ASSETS ARE THE INVESTMENTS IN LOWER TIER INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS. MOORINGS CAPITAL DOES NOT HAVE A CONTROLLING INTEREST IN ANY OF THE LOWER TIER INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS THAT IT OWNS. ALSO, NEITHER H. SMITH RICHARDSON CHARITABLE TRUST NOR ANY OTHER PARTNER/LLC MEMBER HAS ANY CONTROLLING INTEREST IN ANY OF THE LOWER TIER INVESTMENTS THAT ARE OWNED BY MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC.

DURING THE 2018 TAX YEAR THE H. SMITH RICHARDSON CHARITABLE TRUST MADE CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS OF \$3,064,456 TO MOORINGS CAPITAL LLC AND RECEIVED \$6,340,456 OF CAPITAL DISTRIBUTIONS.
