Line 2 - New Activities

During 2017 the Foundation began evaluation of facilities located in the South Ward area of Newark, NJ used for early education programs to determine if there existed sufficient quality facilities suitable for use by exemplary early education programs. It rapidly became apparent that such facilities either did not exist or existed in insufficient numbers to meet the needs of the community. In light of this, the Foundation determined that an appropriate use of its resources was the development of such facilities (the "Project") including strategic planning and community relations. Khaatim Sherrer EI, a well respected community strategist and his company, Results Driven Consulting, were engaged to assist in the planning and community relations components of the Project.

In 2018 the Foundation determined that it would commence construction of a first class early child education facility in the Clinton Hill neighborhood of the South Ward. Development of the facility would be completed in 2 phases. The first phase would be the development of a temporary facility which would be housed in a modular facility to be leased from Mobilease - a leader in the building of modular educational facilities. During 2018 the Foundation negotiated a lease arrangement with Mobilease, negotiated a land lease for the property upon which the temporary facility would be located and spent extensive amounts to prepare the site for the temporary facility. The temporary facility opened in 2019.

The Foundation also began working on the second phase of the development in 2018. This phase, which would be a larger permanent facility, would be on land to be purchased by the Foundation in the Clinton Hill neighborhood. The activities of the Foundation regarding the second phase was limited to preliminary planning and negotiation of an agreement to purchase the land.

It is noted that the Foundation will not actually provide the early childhood education programming but will work with nonprofit partners who currently conduct this type of programming. With respect to the temporary facility the nonprofit partners who will be providing the programming are La Casa De Don Pedro for Head Start/Early Head Start programming and Clinton Hill Community and Early Childhood Center for pre-kindergarten programming. Both of these
