We provide training in groups and one on one through Field Officers/Case Managers Field Officers meet with families to help them identify their gifts and strengths and their goals and then they help them break the goal into achievable parts and make a plan to achieve the goal. Field Officers share devotions and Scripture to help families work through broken relationships that are keeping them in poverty and to encourage them Field Officers use appreciative inquiry to focus on strengths they can build on in families and communities. Through this work, children are able to go to school, get medical care and have more nutritious meals, families are able to build brick homes and start businesses.
