Our current focus is in the area of Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) aka concussions, in young athletes, victims of intimate partner violence (IPV), industrial and motor vehicle accidents, the military and first responders, with a significant attention to addressing health care delivery disparities and underserved populations. Statement of Program Service Accomplishments The CACTIS Foundation continues to lead and coordinate the MC3DV (Maricopa County Collaboration on Concussion from Domestic Violence) with the Maricopa County Attorney's Office Family Violence Bureau, the Mesa and Tempe, Arizona Police Departments, HonorHealth's Scottsdale Family Advocacy Center's Forensic Laboratory, the University of Arizona College of Medicine - Phoenix (UACOM-P), and the Barrow Neurological Institute at Phoenix Children's Hospital (BNI@PCH). The CACTIS Foundation has begun to investigate and address the frequency and impact of TBI in the underrepresented, diverse cohort of intimate partner violence victims (women, children, and men), and participated in educational and baseline concussion testing of youth athletic organizations focusing on concussions. CACTIS is initiating the analysis of data with the goal of creating a concussion registry and developing a concussion assessment program for veterans in the Regional Municipalities Veterans Treatment Court in Tucson, Arizona.
