	In Israel, we are helping not only new immigrants but also the elderly, Holocaust survivors, single mothers and the disabled. The
	mismatch between income and expenses is a matter of end-of-year timing between receiving donations and disbursing the funds.

	We support soup kitchends in a number of cities in Ukraine which feed a large number of people each month in addition to our

	received that were specifically designated for our Ukraine ministry.
