THE MERGER AGREEMENT OBLIGATED THE FOUNDATION TO MAKE MINIMUM CONTRIBUTIONS TO NUH FOR UNCOMPENSATED EMERGENCY ROOM CARE AND OTHER SIMILAR CLINICAL PROGRAMS. FOR YEARS AFTER 2003, THE MINIMUM CONTRIBUTION DIRECTLY TO NUH IS THE GREATER OF \$4,000,000 OR 50% OF THE FOUNDATION'S INVESTMENT EARNINGS. ADDITION, MONETARY SUPPORT TO OTHER ORGANIZATIONS WHICH HELP TO SUSTAIN THE HEALTHCARE MISSION OF NUH WERE \$2,828,192 IN 2018. BEGINNING IN 2019 NUH AGREED TO ACCEPT A REDUCED CONTRIBUTION OF \$3,500,000 TO HELP PERPETUATE THE LIFE OF THE TOTAL SUPPORT EXCEEDED 100% OF THE FOUNDATION'S NET INVESTMENT INCOME FOUNDATION.
