

QUESTION 2(b). Applications should be submitted in writing and include the following information:

- (a) Organization name, address and website;
- (b) Chief Executive Officer name, telephone number and email address;
- (c) Contact person name and title, telephone number and email address;
- (d) Organization Mission Statement and Purpose of Request;
- (e) Funding request - amount requested, who and how many will be served, partnerships, and work plan,
- (f) Financial plan - project budget, development plan, and timing,
- (g) Supporting Material - operating budget, financial budget, review of financial statements, IRS Form 990, Board of Directors and Staff, and IRS Exemption Letter

QUESTION 2(c): The Ameritas Charitable Foundation meets twice a year. In order to be responsive to the needs of the non-profit community, applications received by March 1 will be considered at the April meeting and applications received by October 1 will be considered at the November meeting.

QUESTION 2(d): Preference will be given to requests from qualified applicants located in the State of Nebraska with additional preference given to those applicants in the city of Lincoln and Lancaster County.

All organizations having 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status conferred by the Internal Revenue Service are eligible to apply for funding consideration as long as the organization has two years of audited or reviewed financial statements.

Preference will be given to educational programs, but consideration will be given to civic, cultural, health and welfare requests. Generally, requests for support of debt retirement or operational deficits are not favored.

Funding of any project, program or organization is limited to 10% of the total amount of the project, program or organizational budget. Funding is also limited to 5% of the total amount for capital campaigns.
