Patient Care The Foundation raises money to support activities related to the Gillette mission. This includes offering financial aid to patients based on need, whether or not they have health insurance, and offering charity care to patients who are financially unable to pay all or part of their medical bills. Gillette evaluates each situation based on a patient's income, assets and other resources, and the hospital assists with establishing manageable payment plans (including co-pays and co-insurance). For people without insurance, Gillette charges for care in accordance with the 501(r) guidelines See Schedule O If patients inform Gillette that they will have a difficult time meeting their financial obligations. Gillette helps patients in their efforts to qualify for public assistance or the Gillette charity care program. Income eligibility for the program is based on national poverty guidelines. Gillette will never turn away a family due to an inability to pay for treatment. Additionally, funds raised by the Foundation support areas of

Gillette operations that are unreimbursed or under-reimbursed. For example, Gillette operates Outreach Clinics in communities in greater (largely rural) Minnesota. However, in providing these services, Gillette incurs losses. Gillette Outreach Clinics offer appointments with doctors, nurse practitioners, and seating and adaptive equipment specialists. Outreach clinics also help with care coordination and education for community providers in the specialized needs of Gillette patients living in their communities. Similarly, Gillette provides a variety of services to patients through our Child and Family Services area that are unreimbursed or under-reimbursed. Child life specialists, for example, help children and families prepare for and cope with hospital stays and medical procedures. Social workers provide emotional support and help with practical concerns for families of children who have disabilities, such as ordering medical equipment and finding transportation or other resources

Capital The Foundation raises funds to support Gillette Children's Specialty Healthcare's mission of providing specialized health care for children and adults who have complex and rare medical conditions. The Foundation's support allows Gillette to further its vision of helping patients realize their full potential. This includes raising

Research Gillette research activities concentrate on clinical applications devoted to finding effective medical interventions for disabling conditions and their related effects Research at Gillette consists of fourteen emphasis areas, all of which seek to improve the lives of children who have disabilities and complex conditions. These areas include bone health, cerebral palsy, craniofacial, epilepsy, gait and motion analysis, Legg-Calve-Perthes Disease, musculoskeletal, neuromuscular disease, pain and comfort, Rett syndrome, spina bifida, spine, upper extremities and nursing research See Schedule O During 2018, over 100 active studies were underway and 50 studies were published in peer-reviewed journals and manuscripts. Following are several examples of research studies and advancements. Gillette's Center for Gait and Motion Analysis actively measures and publishes short-term treatment outcomes. There is, however, limited data from any gait and motion center documenting long-term outcomes of treatments. The Long-Term Selective Dorsal Rhizotomy (SDR) Outcomes study examines the long-term effects of treatments for cerebral palsy-a comparison of SDR surgery to standard cerebral palsy treatments without SDR. This study examines matched cohorts of patients in early adulthood and assesses important factors such as pain, function and quality of life Research continues on long-term outcomes associated with distal femoral extension osteotomy and patellar tendon advancement. Distal femoral extension osteotomy and patellar tendon advancement (DFEO-PTA) is a promising, relatively new treatment for persistent crouch gait in children and adolescents who have cerebral palsy. As pioneers in this treatment. Gillette's Center for Gait and Motion Analysis studies short-term outcomes and technique optimization for this surgery. We are now examining long-term outcomes to assess important issues such as maintaining the surgical correction and addressing later complications from the procedure Research into pain assessment in nonverbal patients has also continued to move forward. Findings from a study on spasticity-related pain, experienced by patients before and after an intrathecal bump (ITB) pump placement, has been presented nationally and internationally, and research into assessing pain experienced by patients who have Rett syndrome (a rare disorder that primarily affects females) was published in the journal Paediatric Anaesthesia Gillette is a leader in the treatment of, and research into, a rare orthopedic condition called Legg-Calve-Perthes (LCP) We participate in an international LCP study group and have the world's third-highest number of participants in this study group Ongoing clinical and pre-clinical studies have prognostic, diagnostic and therapeutic implications for treatment of LCP
