Part III, Line 3 - United Way of Mahaska County discontinued the Color Me United 5K and did not collaborate on the Healthy Kids Day in 2018. Part III, Line 4d - Other Program Services Back to School Fair (formerly Operation Backpack/Stuff the Bus) Expenses - \$15,189 - Each summer United Way of Mahaska County sponsors a school supply drive. Any child or youth, (preschool through 12th grade) residing in Mahaska County is eligible for the program. In 2018, a Back to School Fair was organized to distribute backpacks filled with supplies, as well as offer shoes and haircuts. Agencies that offer programming for youth distributed information about their activities. Over 560 backpacks were distributed to families in need. Leftover school supplies were given to local schools to stock school supply closets, which can be utilized by teachers throughout the school year. We partnered with Salvation Army, Mahaska YMCA, Mahaska County Big Brothers Big Sisters, Soles 4 Souls, and the school districts in Mahaska County. lowa Reading Corps Expenses - \$7,930 (including grants of \$7,930) - United Way of Mahaska County provided funding to United Ways of Iowa to sponsor one of two AmeriCorps volunteers at the Oskaloosa Elementary School through their Iowa Reading Corps program. This volunteer worked with students that were identified as needing assistance in order to meet reading proficiency guidelines established by the state. Designated Gifts Expenses - \$6,301 (including grants of \$6,301) - United Way of Mahaska County accepts designated donations from donors during the annual fundraising campaign. Donations are forwarded to designated human service 501(c)3 agencies. Special Grants Expenses - \$3,500 (including grants of \$3,500) - United Way of Mahaska County provided two Special Grants to one local organization in Mahaska County. \$1,500 went to a program that helped local high school students fund a project that provided clothing and Christmas presents to local children in need. \$2,000 went to a program that local high school students used to develop branding and marketing for the school.
