Outside of the work performed by the Executive Director on Foundation-related activites, the Executive Director is also provided compensation from a contract agreement with Affiliates Management Company (AMC). The Foundation and AMC share a common paymaster, and due to this, the compensation outlined above does not match the Executive Director's 2018 W-2 reported income, which also included earnings from the AMC contract. AMC-earned income is not funded by donor dollars.
