Minnesota Behavioral Health Division allows for their grant funds to be used for client relater expenses. The types of approved expenses and guidelines for use are defined in the grant's Request for Proposal (RFP) and contract agreements. The categories are Client Transportation, Client Housing, Client Incentives, Client Emergency Funds. Deaf Can staff would assess the financial needs of the clients being served and work with the client to access and apply for public assistance funding sources in order to meet their needs. In the event that there are no public assistance available or if there is not enough money to support the client, the client will make a written request to the business manager. The request must include these details: the amount needed and purpose for the request. The client shall explain attempts to find other solutions and the results before deciding to make the request.

The business manager will follow up with the client and direct service person to verify the facts and then determine the validity and benefit of awarding financial assistance.

Client Transportation includes bus and taxi fares or other modes of transportation. Client Housing includes rent assistance, security deposits, equipment needed for safety of residents. Client Incentives are used to promote sobriety and meeting program objectives. Assistance includes food, personal needs, social activities, and gift cards. Gift cards are prices at no more than \$20 each and cannot be used for purchasing alcohol, tobacco, licit or illicit drugs, including energy drinks. Client Emergency Funds are used for clients who are transitioning from

temporary living situations or shelters into more permanent housing. That includes personal needs and food supplies, additional furniture for their apartment.
