	Indian Reservation. PRACC has increased marketing schemes for the reservation and Native owned business. Marketing has
	expanded to Minnesota, Colorado, Wisconsin, Missouri, Kansas and North Dakota. PRACC utilizes cooperative marketing campaigns
	through the State of South Dakota Tourism office, the Black Hills and Badlands Tourism association and the American Indian Alaskan
	Native Tourism Association. This type of marketing has increased business on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation and assisted with job creation. PRACC continues to offer workforce development curriculum to area high school students. Training delivered to nine
	students at Crazy Horse School, 15 students at Little Wound School, 15 students at PRACC business camp and four students at
	PRACC fall initiative. Total students is 44. PRACC has in partnership with Little Wound, created a high school elective to provide
	training to students. The curriculum is attached to an existing class at Crazy Horse.
