Because of limits on the government's ability to respond to all the damage across the island, a Go-Fund-Me fund-raising campaign was launched in late 2017 to raise funds to restabilish the road that carries all supplies and other necessities to Fond Blanc. \$72,400 was carried over to 2018 for the project. The road was completed in February 2018. This was a one-time project. Part III - 4d The balance of the funds that were not sent for direct services to the children were spent on maintaining a website, fees for collection of monthly child sponsorships, wire transfer fees, fund-raising expenses and mailing list maintenece.
