It conducts a grant mission to support financially needy veterans and their families in a program called the "Military Families Initiative" (MFI) grant program. Most of the funding for the MFI program was provided by the national Military Officers Association of America, of which Luke Chapter is an affiliate. The Community Fund made two grants of \$1,250 each totaling \$2,500 during the fiscal year to this related organization, Luke Chapter, to support its MFI grant program. During this tax period, the organization stood in a 'brother/sister' relationship with the Community Fund organization (see Schedule R). The total grant amount from the Community Fund of \$2,500 is shown at Part VIII, Line 1d. This sum was in turn then managed and disbursed by Luke Chapter as part of its overall MFI program. The charitable purposes of this veteran's relief grant program are set forth in the Report from the organization dated April 8, 2019 to the national Military Officers Association of America ("MOAA"), copy enclosed. Both Luke Chapter and Community Fund are local affiliates of the national Military Officers Association of America (MOAA) organization The national MOAA granted Luke Chapter \$3,750 in June 2018, to be disbursed in the current tax period (FY 2018-29). This amount, together with the \$1,250 granted by the Community Fund organization for this current tax year, provided the related Luke Chapter organization a total MFI fund of \$5,000 for the current tax year (FY 2018-19). Luke Chapter applied for a follow-on grant from national MOAA in the spring of 2019. MOAA approved and paid Luke Chapter \$5000 in June 2019 to be disbursed in the following fiscal year (FY 2019-20). This Amendment No. 2 to the Articles of Incorporation of the LUKE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP AND VETERANS SUPPORT FUND, INC., confirms, states and establishes the following, to wit:

ARTICLE I.

NAME CHANGE

The name of the nonprofit Corporation is hereby changed from: LUKE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP AND VETERANS SUPPORT FUND, INC., to: LUKE CHAPTER MOAA COMMUNITY FUND, INC.

ARTICLE II.

MEMBERS

Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is revised and amended as follows: The Arizona non-profit corporation LUKE CHAPTER, MILITARY OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA shall be the sole member of the Corporation and shall have the sole power to elect and remove the directors of the Corporation. The Corporation shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE III.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is revised and amended to add these provisions:

Section 6.4 <u>Appointment and Powers of Directors</u>: The directors shall be appointed at all times by the LUKE CHAPTER, MILITARY OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, an Arizona non-profit corporation which is a tax-exempt IRS Code Section 501(c)(19) veterans organization, in accord with the procedures set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

It is intended that the Corporation shall have, and continue to have, the status of an organization which is exempt from federal income taxation under IRS Code Section 501(c)(3) as a public charity. All

terms and provisions of these Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Corporation and all authority and operations of the Corporation, shall be construed, applied and carried out in accordance with such intent.

The directors of the Corporation shall have the powers and duties set forth in these Articles of Incorporation and in the Bylaws, to the extent that such powers and duties are not inconsistent with the status of the Corporation as a non-profit corporation which is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code.

Section 6.5 Officers: The officers of the Corporation shall be the President, Secretary and Treasurer; provided, that the Board of Directors may create additional offices. Officers may be, but need not be, directors.

ARTICLE IV.

NO OTHER CHANGES

No other changes except as stated above are made in the existing Articles of Incorporation of said nonprofit corporation.

This Amendment No. 2 was duly adopted and unanimously approved by the Board of Directors of the LUKE CHAPTER, MOAA, SCHOLARSHIP FUND, INC., effective as of April 9, 2020.



APPENDIX OF CORRESPONDENCE

- The organization's Exempt Organization Return was due on November 15, 2019, six months after the close of its fiscal year on June 30, 2019.
- The organization completed and mailed by USPS its Form 990-EZ, Short Form Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax dated September 5, 2019. The IRS date stamped receipt of this return on September 12, 2019. By letter dated September 25, 2019, this return was rejected by the IRS and returned to the organization (control reference 0422807355). The IRS letter stated that the organization must complete Schedule A, Public Charity Status and Public Support.
- The organization responded by USPS mailing on October 5, with a revised Form 990-EZ, with a correctly completed Schedule A. 2019. The letter of transmittal by oversight was dated September 5, 2019. The letter should have been dated October 5, 2019. The IRS date-stamped receipt of this mailing on October 8, 2019. Note this mailing was still within the required due date of November 15, 2019.
- By letter dated November 18, 2019, the IRS again returned the organization's Form 990-EZ (reference 0425874015). The IRS in this letter directed the organization to file Form 990, stating that a "yes" answer to line 45a on the short form required the organization to file the long Form 990.
- The IRS letter dated November 18 was received by the organization on November 19, 2019, and required a response within ten days. Preparation of the Form 990 in that time was impossible. By letter of transmittal dated November 22, 2019, the organization requested an automatic time extension of six months. That letter was faxed to the IRS at the number given in the IRS letter, and also mailed by USPS certified mail on November 22, 2019. Form 8868, Request for Automatic Extension of Time to File an Exempt Organization Return was included in this transmittal. The USPS returned a return receipt showing delivery of the Form 8868 to the IRS in Ogden, Utah on December 2, 2019.
- The IRS responded to the extension request by letter dated December 16, 2019, approving the application for extension of time to file (reference 0437984673). The extension was granted until May 15, 2020 for filing its Form 990.

Arizona Chapters:

- Notwithstanding the extension request and approved extension of time to file, the IRS sent the organization an additional letter, dated March 04, 2020 (reference 0438900001). This form letter indicates an additional period of 60 days was required by the IRS to "... provide a complete response on what action we are taking on your account. We don't need any further information from you." The wording and purpose of this letter is unclear and confusing, given the extension of time granted by the IRS letter dated December 16, 2019 to file the Form 990.
- Many repeated efforts by the organization to contact the IRS at the phone number given in the letter (877-829-5500) for assistance were unsuccessful. The contact number answered with a recording stating that "due to staffing shortages" the IRS was unable to respond to the calls.
