





Before the start of these deliberations, in keeping with HW's Conflict of Interest Policy, a call is made for Executive Committee members to recuse themselves if there is an actual conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest of the individual, directly or indirectly, including through an immediate family member or member of the individual's household. Should any committee member or trustee have a conflict of interest or a potential conflict of interest as it relates to this matter, he/she (a) shall notify the Executive Committee of such conflict or potential conflict in writing and (b) shall not participate in any consideration and/or action by the Executive Committee as it relates to executive compensation. During these deliberations, the Executive Committee may consider input obtained from other board members, staff, professional advisors, grant recipients, and other informed community leaders. Once a consensus is reached regarding performance, a similar discussion is held concerning compensation relative to annual benchmark and established objectives. Salary surveys for similarly qualified persons in comparable positions at similarly situated organizations such as the annual Archbright Regional Wage & Compensation Survey and the annual Council Staff Salary Report published by the Federation of State Humanities Councils are used to determine compensation benchmarks for the position.
